



## Job Posting: Professor of Data and Business Analytics

Syracuse University invites applications for a Professor of Business Analytics at Whitman School of Management starting January 2020. This recruitment is part of an ambitious Invest Syracuse Cluster Hire Initiative in the broad area of Big Data and Data Analytics. The successful candidate is expected to contribute to this cluster effort, such as obtaining joint extramural funding, joint mentoring and participating in relevant centers or institutes.

Qualified candidate must possess a Ph.D. in data sciences or in a related field. Faculty hired will build on existing strengths on campus in areas, such as Machine Learning, Data Mining, and High Frequency Data Trading, and will participate in organized research efforts that span multiple departments, including the Schools of Management, Engineering and Computer Science, and the College of Arts and Sciences. A main goal of the cluster hire is to increase research visibility of the university through interdisciplinary research and competitive extramural grants. Candidate should have a distinguished record of publications in high quality outlets in Statistics, Econometrics, and functional areas of business. A proven record of funded grants is desirable.

Candidate is also expected to demonstrate excellence in teaching at the undergraduate and graduate levels and commitment to excellence by providing leadership towards building an equitable and diverse scholarly environment. For full consideration, candidates must provide the following documents: a cover letter with brief sections on research and teaching philosophies, curriculum vitae, select research papers, evidence of teaching experience and effectiveness, and three recommendation letters. The application deadline is October 1, 2019, or until the search closes.
