This 12-credit hour program is designed to enhance clinical and translational research capabilities for clinicians, research support staff, and other health professionals. The program focuses on developing skills related to clinical and translational research studies, grantsmanship, data analysis, and the presentation of health outcomes data.

M.S. IN APPLIED HEALTH RESEARCH AND EVALUATION

This non-thesis M.S. program is designed to develop health research support personnel who engage in the practical aspects of a research project. This innovative program is designed to provide students with a foundational overview of both public health and the research methods, data collection, and data analysis techniques most commonly used in health research and evaluation.
